1. Community Outreach Worker- Act as a liaison to Sonoma County Indian Health Project (SCIHP), local community organizations and the Kashia Tribal Community to plan and coordinate community wellness events. The outreach coordinator will also work collaboratively with the "CMHEP" to support, train, outreach and recruit volunteers from the community to help support programs and workshops.

HOURS: 20 hrs/wk: October 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022

SALARY: \$33.25/hour part-time

2. **Fiscal Assistant** -responsible for assisting the Fiscal Officer with the following: Posting accounts payable invoice, printing checks, posting travel advances and reconciliations, maintaining monthly vehicle logs, assisting in pulling grant payments; assist in providing audit materials, maintain Fiscal Office files, and files in Tribal storage, ordering of office supplies, maintaining inventory.

HOURS: 40 hours per week M-F / SALARY: \$25.00-\$35.00 DOE/hour Full-time

5. Housing Assistant: Under the direction of the Housing Authority Executive Director, the Housing Assistant II is responsible for assisting the Executive Director with the following: Carrying out the Housing Rental Assistance and Emergency Assistance Programs, providing support to the Executive Director, maintaining Housing files for all programs, working with all tenants (on and off the Rancheria), processing applications and determining eligibility. HOURS: 40 hours per week M-F / SALARY: \$21.00-\$26.00 DOE/hour

6. Kashia Construction Laborers: Responsible for preparing materials, tools, equipment, clean and clearing debris at construction sites. Laborers will also perform general task which include loading and unloading materials, installing dry wall, windows, painting, demolition and other task needed. **HOURS: varies / SALARY: \$15.00-\$20.00**




WATER TOWER & CELL TOWER ON THE RESERVATION



Left: The Kashaya Utility District is upgrading the drinking water systems raw water feed tank. This is a collaborative watershed project initiated in 2017 by the Gualala River Watershed Council, intended to increase water storage and reduce water draws from the Gualala River during low flows/drought conditions. Funded by Prop. 84, the Utility is now working with the Mendocino County Resource Conservation District to complete the project. The new tank will triple the capacity of the old tank, improving the Utility's storage and water processing efficiency. Once complete, the Tribe plans to paint the tank green to match the Utility's larger filtered water tank.
