### KASHIA CLEAN UP PROJECT ON ALL TRIBAL LANDS

The Kashia Band of Pomo Indians has received a grant called "Clean California" funded by the California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) to assist with a cleanup project on all Kashia Lands. We are seeking workers for this project, see below. This is a 6-month project.

#### LABORERS - \$27.00 / hour

The Kashia Band of Pomo Indians is currently looking to fill 6 temporary laborer positions to assist with the cleanup on all Tribal Lands. This is a 6-month position at 40 hours a week.

##### Applicants must:

- Pass pre-employment drug/alcohol screen
- Be able to lift loads up to 50lbs and navigate job site terrain
- Proficient in use of a range of hand and power tools; safety training will be provided
- Be able to identify and eliminate job site hazards.

**Essential Duties & Responsibilities:** Laborers are responsible for carrying out the goals & objectives of this Cleanup Project. Laborers will use approved methods to clear areas of a variety of debris (i.e. household rubbish, white goods, tires, scrap metal). Work will be done using multiple-power and hand tools and vehicles. Laborers will be under direct supervision but should have the ability to work both independently and in a team environment. Laborers must be able to follow verbal and written instructions. Complete other activities as directed.

#### CLEAN-UP SUPERVISOR - \$45.00 / hour

The Kashia Band of Pomo Indians is currently looking to fill 1 temporary supervisor position to supervise 6 laborers for the Tribes Cleanup Project on all Tribal Lands. This is a 6-month position at 40 hours a week.

##### Applicants must:

- Pass pre-employment drug/alcohol screen & background check
- Be able to lift loads up to 50lbs and navigate job site terrain
- Proficient in use of a range of hand and power tools
- Be able to identify and eliminate job site hazards.
- Have a Valid California Driver License w/ insurable driving record
- Management Experience

**Essential Duties & Responsibilities:** This Supervisor position is responsible for carrying out the goals & objectives of this Cleanup Project. The Supervisor will manage project labor force, ensure site safety, record, and report progress as requested. Supervisor will be proficient in the use of multiple-power and hand tools, trucks, and utility vehicles, conduct safety training and more. Supervisor will maintain confidentiality of all privileged information.

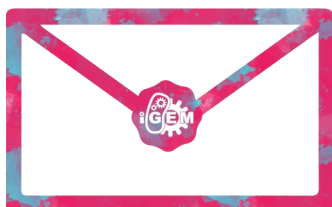

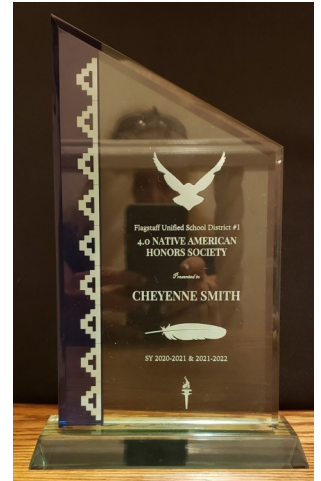
## Kashia Kids Shine!
